(Micah 5:2). But what if Micah is also talking to us, proclaiming, "But you, O Elizabethtown United Methodist Church, from you shall come forth for me..." What? Congregation: God invites us to receive the promise of God's salvation and the sustenance of God's mercy and grace, enabling us to live the promise as God-bearers to the world.
